Students must be enrolled in a public high school located in the Southeast part of Houston. Currently, zip code areas are 77021 or 77051.

Students must have applied to an accredited college or university as full-time students (minimum 12 credit hours per term) and must be accepted at the accredited college or university before the scholarship will be awarded.

Strength of Character-as evidenced by: service to school and community; letters of recommendation; personal essay; and interview.

Strong Scholastic Ability-an ACT or SAT score and GPA that will allow the student to be accepted in an institution of higher learning.

Application Deadline

Applications will be accepted beginning Monday, April 4th, 2023. Applications must be received no later than Friday, April 23rd, 2023, to be considered for an award.

Notification of Winners

Scholarship recipients will be notified by Friday, May 20, 2023.
